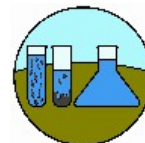

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

Students learn about the water cycle, the physical science of ground and surface water, the treatment and distribution systems and the interactions between water and technology in their daily lives.



HEALTH & SAFETY

Students learn about the safety around water & its role in human health.



CONSERVATION & PROTECTION

Students investigate how human activity can impact water. They learn how to conserve, protect and manage water at home, at school & in the community.



WATER & SOCIETY

Students learn about the history of water, the relationship between people, the uses of water & how to become stewards in their local & global communities.
